Paper requirements

- The paper must be of **3-4 full pages** (including illustrations and list of literature) and preceded with an English language abstract.
- The paper text must be in Times New Roman font (or similar) 12 pt single-spaced. The abstract text must be in italic style (11 pt). The paper must be printed on white A4 sheets.
- Pages should not be numbered. Margins: top and bottom 20 mm, left and right 25 mm.
- The paper title must be formatted in all caps, bold face print.
- The list of authors with their places of work, addresses, telephone/fax numbers, e-mail addresses (in small letters) must be placed under the paper title.
- Awards, academic degrees and statuses should not be indicated.
- The paper title and the list of authors (including place of work, address, telephone, etc.), the list of the authors and the abstract, the abstract and the paper text must be separated with a blank line.
- The paper text must be structured and have all the main parts of a research study description, i.e.: **introduction** (describing the relevance of the research study, formulating its purposes and tasks); **main part** (containing the description of the research study itself); **conclusions** (containing the results of the study, their novelty and practical significance).
- Formulae, symbols, variables used in the text must be formatted in Microsoft Equation 3.0 with the following character sizes: variable – 12 pt, large index – 10 pt, small index – 8 pt.
- Figures and tables must be distinct and compact.
- Formulae must be numbered in brackets.
- References must be given in square brackets.

Participants are welcome to submit papers on the following types of measurements: Acoustics; Length and Angle; Time and Frequency; Ionizing Radiation; Mass and Related Quantities; Flow; Optics and Laser Technology; Radio Electronics; Temperature; Physical Chemistry; Photometry and Radiometry; Electricity and Magnetism.

Important dates:

- 1 June** – deadline for application form submittal for participants with paper;
1 June – deadline for paper submittal;
1 September – deadline for application form submittal for participants without paper;
1 October – deadline for payment submittal;
8-9 October – arrival of the participants;
9 October – opening of the conference.



Submittal requirements

Papers (3-4 full pages) may be submitted in Ukrainian, Russian or English (at option). Basic, review and subject-determining papers will be considered at the plenary sessions.

Participants must meet the following requirements to have their papers included into the conference programme and published in the conference proceedings (on the CD):

- submit an application form;
- bring the paper topic to conformity with the subject of the conference;
- submit the paper in the required format to the Organizing Committee;
- pay the organization fee in proper time.

After receiving an application form from you, there will be sent at your address an invoice for payment of organization fee, contract and act of conducted works in two copies.

The organization fee is **60 EURO** per a participant.

The organization fee includes the publication of the proceeding of the conference (on the CD), rental of premises, communication costs, technical support and other costs relating to the organization and conducting of the conference.
