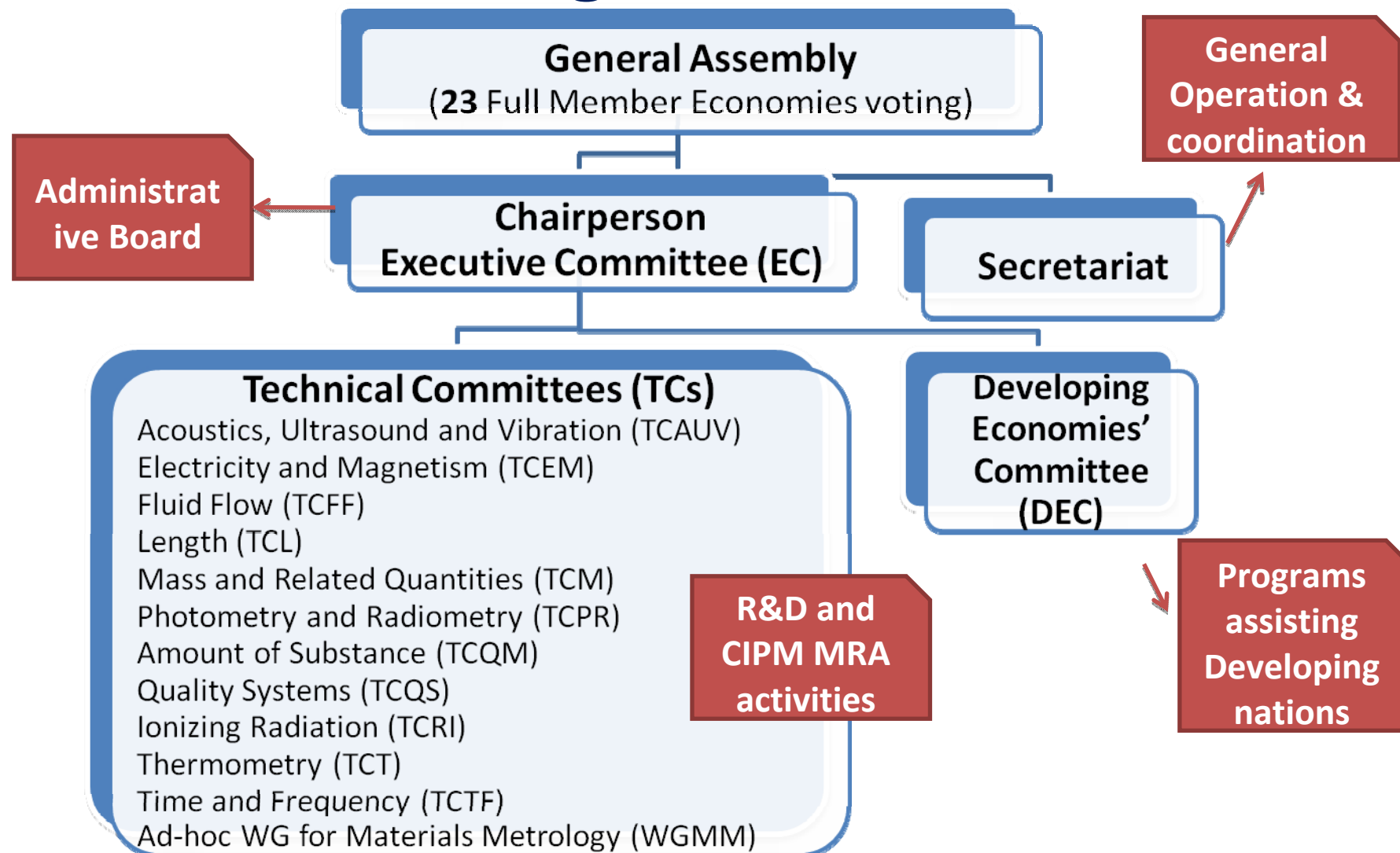

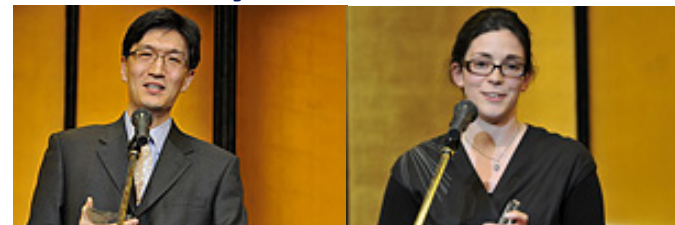
# Highlights of APMP GA 2011

- ~10 satellite workshops or trainings organized by TCs

## GA Key decisions

### Approval of:

- **The APMP Work plan and the Budget** for 2012, noting that the **“TC Initiatives”** budget for FY11/12 will be **increased to \$40,000**.
- **Changing APMP’s fiscal year** (currently from 1 October to 30 September) to be from 1 January to 31 December starting from the year of 2013.
- **The APMP-APLMF MoU.**
- The decision **to open**, from the year 2012, **a new Award** to recognize remarkable contributions of individuals from developing NMIs in establishing new laboratories and/or improving metrology capacity in their economy.



## “TC INITIATIVES”

### *2011 conclusion & 2012 new launch*

- In 2010, the APMP EC established a small pool of funds, the “TC initiatives” budget, to support collaborative research initiatives and comparison activities among and between APMP’s TCs. Reports at the 2011 midyear meetings on the status of activities undertaken using this new budget testified to the success of this initiative.
- As a result, the APMP EC proposed an increase in the "TC Initiatives" budget from US\$20k to US\$40k to support 6-12 projects. This proposal was approved by GA 2011.
- Proposal collection and evaluation for FY 2011/2012 has been finished. US\$12,000 was allocated to fund 4 projects:
  1. *TCAUV: Research for free-field calibration in acoustics*
    - Jointly proposed by KRISS, NIM, CMS and NMIA, this project develops a free-field calibration procedure and is to organize an inter-comparison among APMP NMIs for free-field reciprocity calibration of microphone, to link the corresponding KC that many NMIs in APMP didn’t join.



## “TC INITIATIVES”

### *2011 conclusion & 2012 new launch*

2. *TCM: APMP pilot study on Torque in the range of 0 N·m, 500 N·m, 1000 N·m* This proposal develops a comparison protocol and conducts a pilot study for torque in the range of 0 N·m, 500 N·m, 1000 N·m.
3. *TCPR: APMP Pilot Study on Total Spectral Radiant Flux*
  - This proposal holds a pilot comparison on Total Spectral Radiant Flux, especially for LEDs, among NMIs, which will be the first APMP comparison on total spectral radiant flux.
4. *TCTF: GNSS receiver calibration exercise along with the Asia-Pacific Workshop on Time and Frequency (ATF) 2012*
  - The project is to hold a GNSS calibration exercise in conjunction with the ATF 2012 in Wellington, New Zealand in late November, to identify current needs on GNSS calibration and suitable equipment and start the TCTF GNSS calibration campaigns, with a view to discuss with EURAMET about harmonizing the procedure to report results to BIPM.



## 2 workshops during the 2011 Mid-year Meetings in Mongolia

### Workshop on “Strategic Planning & Regional Roadmapping”

Objectives:

- Identify areas specific to APMP that would benefit from EMRP-style Inter-NMI collaboration;
- Provide TC Chairs with specific skills of initiating and creating roadmaps
- Facilitate strategic dialog between TC Chairs and Executive

### The 1<sup>st</sup> Inter-RMO Workshop on Activities in Support of Small, Emerging and Developing Economy NMIs,

DEC+PTB organized, chaired by Dr Robert Kaarls, attended by reps of APMP, AFRIMETS, COOMET, EURAMET and SIM. **A new platform for DEN policy dialogues among RMOs, and a successful try toward establishing potential collaboration among RMOs for high an efficiency and effectiveness in carrying out supporting activities for DENs.**

# Enhanced collaboration with stakeholder organizations

**APMP's contacts & collaborations with SOs great enhanced since 2010 after adopting a series of new policies:**

1. APMP will have an annual review and prioritization of SOs
2. APMP will increase its representation in SO activities (via EC members' participation) with cost shared by NIM and APMP
3. APMP will invite CIPM members from the region to attend annual GA and Directors' Workshop
4. APMP is in a process of establishing cooperation framework with more SOs and organize more joint activities for meaningful outcomes





## **APMP's role in APEC FSCF PTIN**

- APMP, together with the other APEC SRBs, supports the work of APEC in particular through the SCSC and its work programs. Since 2009, APMP has been the nominated-SRB representative to the APEC Food Safety Cooperation Forum (FSCF)'s Partnership Training Institute Network (PTIN).**





## APMP-APLAC

- **APMP-APLAC MoU** signed in 2008, **annual Chairs Meeting** held since 2007
- In 2011, two APMP comparisons (in food safety) were initiated, linked to concurrent APLAC PT programs in order to provide reference values for the APLAC programs. The two PT programs are to be completed in 2012.
- During the 2012 Chairs Meeting in Beijing, APMP tabled a proposal from the APMP TCQM Chair to further strengthen collaboration in order to disseminate the metrological traceability to field laboratories in the Asia-Pacific region through ***incorporation of measurement uncertainty for PT programs in the area of chemical measurements.***



## APMP-APLAC (cont')

- **Recommended joint efforts include the followings:**
  - That a joint working group or taskforce be set up to further discuss possible collaboration.
  - That the TCQM proposes to APLAC's PT Committee conducting PT programs with metrologically traceable reference values provided by APMP. Candidate studies in 2012/13 that are being planned are:
    - Determination of the residues of a veterinary chemicals in a food matrix; and
    - Determination of trace elements (Cd, Ni, Pb and Ca) in drinking water
