We are glad to invite you to participate in the **IV International competition “Best young metrologist of COOMET – 2011”**, which will take place in June, 15th – 17th, 2011 in **Moscow, Russian Federation**.

According to COOMET R/GM/18:2010 (enclosed), the employees of metrological institutes and other bodies under 35 years, working in the sphere of COOMET metrological activities can take part in the competition. The spheres are:

- general and legal metrology;
- measurements theory;
- standards and measuring instruments;
- research in the field of physical and chemical measurements;
- information technologies and systems;
- results of COOMET projects underlining COOMET’s role in regional and international cooperation.

To take part in the competition please send (by post and e-mail komissarov@vniims.ru, sedova@vniims.ru) the following documents:

- 2 copies of the report in one of the working languages (Russian, English) drawn up in the accordance of with the enclosed requirements of COOMET R/GM/18:2010;
- digital version of the report;
- accreditation of the applicant (Appendix 1 of COOMET R/GM/18:2010);
- information about scientific and practical activity of the applicant (Appendix 2 of COOMET R/GM/18:2010);

- extract from the minutes of the scientific (scientific & technical) council meeting (Appendix 3 of COOMET R/GM/18:2010).

Authors should sign only the 2nd copy of the report; the authors have to add an explicit permission that their papers can be printed.

Deadline for submitting of the complete report and corresponding papers is May 10, 2011.
The papers, sent after 10th of May 2011 will not be accepted.

The travelling and accommodation costs of one participant from each COOMET member state will be covered by PTB. Three best contributes will receive a financial award.

The workshop, dedicated to 20th anniversary of COOMET is planned for 15th of June. The merited figures of COOMET will deliver reports about history of COOMET establishment, its development and successes.
